The Timing of the End of the Ark's Journey:

- The first Passover took place in Egypt on the 14th day of the 7th month.
- The Lord commanded Israel to celebrate the Feast of Passover annually, and "reset" its calendar to make the 7th month the first month. This made Passover fall on the 14th day of the first month. (Cf. Exodus 12:1-6)
- Jesus was crucified on a Passover.

Then the ark rested in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat. - Genesis 8:4

- We are close to 2,000 years from Pentecost. (Cf. Acts 2)
