Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. - Acts 2:37-38

Peter describes Jesus as:

- God's "servant" in V.13 (Cf. Matthew 12:18-21 [quoting Isaiah 42:1–4], 20:28; John 6:38, 8:28, 13:1-7)
- "the Holy and Righteous One" in V14
- "the source of life" in V.15
- "Messigh" in V.18

...you are saved by grace through faith, and this (the faith) is not from yourselves; it is God's gift - not from works, so that no one can boast. - Ephesians 2:8-9

V.18: Peter explains that the prophesied

and

Messiah are one and the same person, Jesus of Nazareth.

...we speak God's hidden wisdom in a mystery, a wisdom God predestined before the ages for our glory. None of the rulers of this age knew this wisdom, because if they had known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of alory. - 2 Corinthians 2:7-8

"It is necessary that the Son of Man suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, be killed, and be raised the third day." - Luke 9:22

"Let these words sink in: The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men." But they did not understand this statement; it was concealed from them so that they could not grasp it... - Luke 9:44-45

Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. He also said to them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead the third day, and repentance for foraiveness of sins will be proclaimed in his name to all the nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. - Luke 24:45-48
