

Daniel 1: When Home Is Not Home

Then Isaiah said to Hezekiah, "Hear the word of the Lord of hosts: 'Behold, the days are coming when all that is in your house, and what your fathers have accumulated until this day, shall be carried to Babylon; nothing shall be left,' says the Lord. - Isaiah 39:5-6

...(they have also built the high places of Baal, to burn their sons with fire for burnt offerings to Baal, which I did not command or speak, nor did it come into My mind), therefore behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "that this place shall no more be called Tophet or the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, but the Valley of Slaughter. – Jeremiah 19:5-6

And he brought out the wooden image (Asherah pole) from the house of the Lord, to the Brook Kidron outside Jerusalem, burned it at the Brook Kidron and ground it to ashes... Then he tore down the ritual booths of the perverted persons (male cult prostitutes) that were in the house of the Lord... - 2 Kings 23:6-7
