1. Mankind is ______.

"Intersex" does not mean "neither male nor female." More than sixteen different conditions are classified as intersex, also called "difference of sex development" (DSD) or "disorders of sex development." These conditions include atypical features in a person's sex chromosomes, reproductive organs, or anatomical sex (or two of the three, or all three). Depending on which conditions are being considered, the prevalence of intersex conditions ranges anywhere from 0.022 percent of the population to 1.7 percent. Not all intersex conditions are the same.



2. Man and woman have the same _____.
