V.11: Real worship is always
The 3 Gifts:
 Gold represented Jesus as Frankincense represented Jesus as Priest (see Leviticus). Myrrh represented Jesus as (see Mark 15:23 & John 19:39).
These 3 gifts represent the 3 offices of Jesus Christ.
VV.13-15: A spiritual mountaintop is often followed by a spiritual
The magi's gifts Mary & Joseph's flight to Egypt and their new life there.
"Out of Egypt I called My Son" refers to Hosea 11:1.
V.18: Refers to Jeremiah 31:15.
Rachel was Jacob's favourite wife. While on her way to Bethlehem, she died giving birth to Benjamin and was buried in Ramah.

Jeremiah 31 is fulfilled in Jeremiah 40.
A complete view of prophecy includes prediction,
fulfillment, and sometimes
Jeremiah 31:15 = prophecy Jeremiah 40 = fulfillment Matthew 2:16 = pattern
Egypt represents in Scripture.
V.23: Nazareth's Hebrew root word is "netser" (nay-tser), which means "branch".
"Nazareth" means "sprout town" or "bean town".
There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a <u>Branch</u> ("netser") shall grow out of his roots Isaiah 11:1
See Jeremiah 31:16-17.
"Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time - houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions - and in the age to come, eternal life." - Mark 10:29-30
