# Revelation chapter 2&3 contain 7 letters, written by Jesus, to 7 churches. Each of these letters is:

- To a local church
- To all churches
- To each of us as individuals
- Prophetic

The Book of Acts covers about the first 30 years of the Church; Chapters 2 and 3 of the Book of Revelation cover the next ~2,000 years.

# Each church is unique because of its:

- Name
- The title Jesus gives Himself
- Their "report card"
