

## I Am Jesus: The Beatitudes Matthew 5:1-12 & Luke 6:24-26

**VV.1-2:** Jesus is teaching \_\_\_\_\_ –  
not the crowd.

The Beatitudes reveal the \_\_\_\_\_ that lead to  
\_\_\_\_\_ (“be-attitudes”).

**V.3** addresses our attitude toward \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.4** addresses our attitude toward our own \_\_\_\_\_.

2 ways to mourn your own sin – under \_\_\_\_\_  
from the Holy Spirit or under \_\_\_\_\_ from  
Satan.

See Micah 7 & Luke 7:36-50 for Godly mourning.

**V.5** addresses our attitude toward \_\_\_\_\_.

“meek” (“praus” in Greek) =  
gentleness, enduring with patience and without  
resentment, great strength and power under control.

See Matthew 11:29 & Mark 9:33-35

**V.6** addresses our attitude toward \_\_\_\_\_ and  
the \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.7:** We are \_\_\_\_\_ because we have  
been shown *incalculable* \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.8:** To be “*pure in heart*” means having an

**V.9:** \_\_\_\_\_ is far more important than

**VV.10-12:** ...all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus  
will suffer persecution. – 2 Timothy 3:12

as evil, for the Son of Man's sake.” – Luke 6:22*
