Chorazin, Bethsaida, & Capernaum:

Jewish cities close to the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee

Tyre and Sidon:

Gentile Phoenician cities on the Mediterranean, destroyed by God's judgement as prophesied in Ezekiel 26-28

Sodom:

Judged by God and destroyed in Genesis 19

Mary, Sister of Lazarus & Martha:

Anointed Jesus' head with ointment and wiped His feet with her hair in the house of Simon the leper in Bethany during Passion Week. The objection was wastefulness.

"a woman... who was a sinner" (v.37):

A prostitute at the house of Simon the Pharisee in Galilee, who wept on Jesus' feet, dried them with her hair, kissed them, and then anointed them with oil. The objection was her moral depravity.
