V.2: "the tradition of the elders" = oral law passed down since the Babylonian captivity but believed by the Jews to have originated with Moses.

But you say, 'If a man says to his father or mother,
"Whatever profit you might have received from me is Corban"' (that is, a gift to God)... - Mark 7:11
"Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the Lord your God is giving you." - Exodus 20:12 (the $5^{\text {th }}$ Commandment)
V.6: Jesus pointed out that the scribes and Pharisees were choosing to disobey $\qquad$ in order to keep their traditions.
V.9: The Jewish leadership was teaching man's
$\qquad$ as God's Word.
V.19: "evil thoughts" = evil reasoning within oneself
"fornications" = "porneia" in Greek. (E.G. sex outside of marriage, pornography, same-sex intercourse, bestiality, incest, etc.)
V.18: The $\qquad$ condition of our heart
determines our $\qquad$ behaviours.
