**V.1:** Jesus is speaking of His imminent \_\_\_\_\_.

*His face shone like the sun.* - Matthew 17:2

*And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.* - John 1:14

*"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill."* - Matthew 5:17

*Elijah & Moses appear again possibly at Jesus' tomb following His resurrection (cf. Luke 24:4) and in Revelation 11 as the 2 Witnesses.*

And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid. But Jesus came and touched them and said, "Arise, and do not be afraid." When they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only.* - Matthew 17:5-8
