V.20: "You have a demon" = "You're crazy"

V.21: Jesus is referring to the lame man He healed at the Pool of Bethesda in John 5:1-18

"...man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." - 1 Samuel 16:7

V.27: Refers to the then-popular misinterpretations of Isaiah 53:8 & Malachi 3:1
