



I Am Jesus:  
Little Prayers, Big Power  
Luke 11:1-13

There is \_\_\_\_\_ power in \_\_\_\_\_ prayers.

*In Luke's Gospel, we see Jesus' lifestyle of prayer modeled in 4:42, 5:16, 6:12, 9:18 & 28, and several other times.*

The Disciples' observation and conclusion was that Jesus' power came from His \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.1:** "John" = John the Baptist

If John the Baptist and Jesus needed to \_\_\_\_\_ in order to have God's \_\_\_\_\_ in their lives, we can trust that we do as well!

*For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. O Lord of hosts, blessed is the man who trusts in You! - Psalm 84:11-12*

**V.13:** A \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit is always available to God's children.

*For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God... - Romans 8:15-16*
