**V.15:** "Beelzebub" = "Lord of the Flies" (*a Jewish name for Satan*)

**V.16:** "a sign from Heaven" = *a miraculous work of cosmological proportions*

**VV.17-19:** Jesus points out their argument is \_\_\_\_\_
