## Mark 12 // The Widow's Mites:

V.42: 2 "mites" = a "quadrans" = smallest unit of Roman currency ( $\$ 2.50$ if you make $\$ 20$ per hour)

Jesus doesn't stop her from giving because He knows that $\qquad$ His Father is always the
most $\qquad$ decision a person can make.

"the end" in VV.3, 6, \& 14 refers to the major end times events, beginning with the Rapture
"the end" in V. 13 refers to the end of their earthly lives

VV.9-13 refers to events that take place during the first generation of $\qquad$ .
V.7: "nation" = "ethnos" in the original Greek (ethnic group)
"pestilences" = fatal, epidemic disease
V.8: "sorrows" = "ōdin" in the original Greek (labour pains/contractions)

Everything Jesus lists will occur with increasing
$\qquad$ and $\qquad$ as the
end times approach.

Contrast V. 9 with Luke 21:12: "Then" vs. "But before all these things"
