**Luke 23:9:** Herod had already heard truth (i.e. John the Baptist), so He did not receive \_\_\_\_\_ of it.

Envy always causes you to miss the incredibly \_\_\_\_\_ that are right in front of you.

...(Pilate) knew that the chief priests had handed Him (Jesus) over because of envy. - Mark 15:10

...(Barabbas) had been thrown into prison for a certain rebellion made in the city, and for murder. - Luke 23:19

- Matthew 27:19

When Pilate saw that he could not prevail at all, but rather that a tumult was rising, he took water and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, "I am innocent of the blood of this just Person. You see to it." And all the people answered and said, "His blood be on us and on our children." - Matthew 27:24-25

If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.  
- 2 Timothy 2:13

For the children of Israel shall abide many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred pillar, without ephod or teraphim. Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the Lord their God and David their king. They shall fear the Lord and His goodness in the latter days. - Hosea 3:4-5
