*Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the
blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for
us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over
the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full
assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil
conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- Hebrews 10:19-22*

*...Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of
those who have fallen asleep. - 1 Corinthians 15:20*

*So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God,
saying, "Certainly this was a righteous Man!" And the whole crowd
who came together to that sight, seeing what had been done,
beat their breasts and returned. - Luke 23:47-48*

*So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He
cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was
the Son of God!" - Mark 15:39*
