**V.6:** We are called to \_\_\_\_\_ the love and character of God.

*"He who has seen Me has seen the Father." - John 14:9*

word = "logos" in the Greek in V.6, 14, 17, 20, referring to doctrine, teachings, the Word of God, the Scriptures

words = "rhema" in the Greek in V.8, referring to a word from God for a specific moment

**V.11:** Our salvation was \_\_\_\_\_ by Jesus and is \_\_\_\_\_ by the Father.
