V.42/46: Discipleship requires devotion to spending ______ with other disciples.

Possible reasons the early church met every day:

- 1. They were a part of a minority.
- 2. They were a family.
- 3. A lot of them were still on vacation.
- 4. Church was awesome!
- 5. It's how Jesus discipled the 12.

Have you ever wondered how Jesus' disciples developed so radically, so quickly?

• It wasn't solely because they had Jesus as their teacher.

Nevertheless, I am telling you the truth. It is for your benefit that I go away, because if I don't go away the Counselor will not come to you. If I go, I will send him to you. - John 16:7

• It wasn't because they had so much untapped potential to be super disciples.

When they observed the boldness of Peter and John and realized that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed and recognized that they had been with Jesus. - Acts 4:13

• Can I suggest that a key factor might have been the time they spent in fellowship with each other centred around Jesus?

Based on studies in elite performance, Malcolm Gladwell contended that it's "an extraordinarily consistent answer in an incredible number of fields ... you need to have practiced, to have apprenticed, for 10,000 hours before you get good."

Here are some pushbacks that people may raise to the idea of spending meaningful time with other disciples in fellowship:

Pushback #1 - Our culture

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride in one's possessions—is not from the Father, but is from the world. And the world with its lust is passing away, but the one who does the will of God remains forever. - 1 John 2:15-17
