*"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand." - John 10:27-29*

*For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. - Romans 8:38-39*

**VV.2-3:** God always provides the \_\_\_\_\_ that is needed for the \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.4:** The 144,000 are defined by their radical \_\_\_\_\_.

**V.11** makes it clear that those who reject Jesus will not simply \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_.  
(See Matthew 13:41-42, 49-50; 25:46)

**VV.14-16** likely depict Jesus reaping the final \_\_\_\_\_ (in The Tribulation).  
(See Daniel 7:13-14; Romans 11:25)

**VV.17-20** appear to depict the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ at the Second Coming.

**V.20:** "the city" = Jerusalem  
See Joel 3:12-17 & Isaiah 63:1-6  
"up to the horses' bridles" = ~4 feet high  
a furlong = ~600 feet  
"one thousand six hundred furlongs" = 176 miles  
(the distance between Megiddo and Petra)
