V.14: The "armies in heaven" will include the Church, Tribulation saints, Old Covenant saints, and the angels. (Cf. Revelation 19:7-8; Zechariah 14:5; Revelation 7:9; Daniel 12:1-2; Matthew 25:31)

But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked. - Isaiah 11:4

So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs (~176 miles). - Revelation 14:19-20
