VV.1-2: ______ will be bound in the ______ for the duration of the Millennium.

"...'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, who shook kingdoms (?)..." - Isaiah 14:16

Satan cannot be presently "bound" based upon Matthew 13:39; Acts 5:3; 10:38; 1 Corinthians 7:5; 2 Corinthians 2:10-11; 4:4; 11:14; 12:7; Ephesians 2:2; 4:27; 6:10-20; 1 Thessalonians 2:18; 2 Thessalonians 2:9; 1 Timothy 5:15; 2 Timothy 2:26; James 4:7; and 1 Peter 5:8.

V.3: Satan is presently ______ the nations.

...the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. For "who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ. - 1 Corinthians 2:14-16

Who goes into the Millennium?

- The Church
- Old Testament saints
- Tribulation saints
- Surviving ethnic Israel

V.5: "the rest of the dead" refers to all who rejected Jesus and died before the Second Coming.

"the first resurrection":

- Is a class of people rather than an individual event.
- Jesus was the "_____" of the first resurrection.

...now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ...each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. – 1 Corinthians 15:20, 23

- Includes everyone who belongs to Jesus and is therefore destined to receive a resurrected body, fit for the ages to come.
- V.6: Those who are born once die twice. Those who are born twice die once.

The Millennium is spoken of in Isaiah 2:2-4; 11:6-9; 35:1-2, 5-7; 65:18-26; and Zephaniah 3:9.
