- o Length, breadth, and height each equal 1,500 miles / 2,414km.
- o "twelve foundations" = 12 floors/levels?
- o Each floor would be 125 miles / 201km high
- o 1,440,000,000 acres per floor/level
- o The wall is 72 yards / 216' thick
