See Acts 14:11-15 for Paul and Barnabas being treated as gods in Lystra.

*I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. When I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who had shown them to me. But he said to me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you, your brothers the prophets, and those who keep the words of this book. Worship God!"*  
- Revelation 22:8-9

*Jesus let out a loud cry and breathed his last. Then the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. When the centurion, who was standing opposite him, saw the way he breathed his last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"*  
- Mark 15:37-39

See Matthew 8:5-13 and Luke 7:1-10 for the interaction between Jesus and the centurion in Capernaum.

*For the LORD your God is the God of gods and Lord of lords, the great, mighty, and awe-inspiring God, showing no partiality and taking no bribe. He executes justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the resident alien, giving him food and clothing. You are also to love the resident alien, since you were resident aliens in the land of Egypt.* - Deuteronomy 10:17-19
